1. One (1) wireless microphone with on/off switch if possible. (If Richard is performing/ speaking from a stage.) Lapel Mic is preferred.
2. CD player which is patched into the main system.
3. A sound/lighting technician (If Richard is performing from a stage.)

Sheets can be purchased at stores like Wal-Mart, K-Mart (we like Martha Stewart brand) or on the web at www.ambiancelinens.com. Do not purchase whole sets or very high thread counts. Both are a waste of money. We recommend the thread count be in a range of 200 to 270. Anything higher than 270 is too satiny and will not hold the chalk.
